WHAT BIBLE SAYS ABOUT LIFE IN THE WOMB?

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus, in my previous article I have explained how the modern medical science shows that human life begins at conception. I have concluded my article saying that our human life is a wonderful creation of God. I would like to explain in this article what Sacred Scripture says about Life in the womb. Several passages in the Bible tell us that life in the womb is sacred and comes from God. Psalm 139:13-18 is a wonderful passage that speaks about Life in the womb: "For it was you who formed my inward parts; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works." This passage expresses so beautifully that it is God who is the Creator of life in the womb; "For it was you who formed my inward parts, knit me together in my mother's womb." What a unique way to express God forming us in the womb, you knit me together in my mother's womb. The natural response to this is to praise God as does the Psalmist: I praise you Lord, for the wonder of my being, wonderful are your works. Then the Psalmist goes on to describe how God knew all about us during gestation in the womb: "Already you knew my soul, my body held no secret from you when I was being fashioned in secret and molded in the depths of the earth (Psalm 139:15)". There are several more passages in the Bible describing God forming the baby in the womb. This is Job talking to God in chapter 10 of the Book of Job. Job says: "Did you not pour me out like milk and then thicken me like curds clothe me with skin and flesh, and weave me of bone and sinew?
