WHY SHOULD WE CONFESS SINS TO A PRIEST?

We are in the season of advent. The church invites all of us to participate in the Advent penance service. We are coming closer to our advent penance services in our cluster parishes. Most of us would like to go to priests to make confessions at this service. Why should we confess sins to a priest? Since Jesus is the one and only mediator between God and us (1 Tim. 2:5) shouldn't Christians confess their sins directly to Jesus? Just as God empowered his priests to be instruments of forgiveness in the Old Testament (Leviticus 19:20–22), Christ delegated authority to his New Testament ministers to act as mediators of reconciliation as well. Catholics do confess their sins directly to God both within and outside the confessional because Jesus advocated praying directly to the Father and to ask forgiveness for our sins (Matt. 6:12), and Catholics do this communally at every Mass and in prayer groups, and individually during private prayers. But Catholics also believe that Jesus gave the Church a unique role in his ministry of reconciliation by entrusting it with his power to forgive and retain sins. By administering the sacrament of reconciliation (confession), the priest perpetuates this ministry by acting in persona Christi, "in the person of Christ." (To be continued...)
