Receiving the Holy Communion

Once you arrive at the sanctuary, what then? I would like to say a few words about receiving communion on the tongue and receiving in the hand. It's true that the more ancient way of receiving communion was in the hand. You are about to receive the Lord God Himself. Be on your guard, therefore, against any lack of reverence. Here is a very practical point. Those who are ordained may take the Holy Eucharist themselves. Those who are not ordained receive the Eucharist; they never take it. Don't reach for it, wait until the Body of Christ is given to you. And take to heart the words of the centurion: "Lord, I am not worthy that you should come under my roof, but speak only a word, and my soul shall be healed". Along with sentiments of unworthiness there should be sentiments of joy and gladness. The ancient way of receiving communion in the hand gradually changed, however, as a response to occasions of abuse. By the early Middle Ages the custom had changed, and communion on the tongue was the rule. Here again, we have to be taught. Some people barely open their mouths, and it is difficult for the priest to place the host on their tongue. Some people open their mouth too wide and stick out their tongue too far, and there is danger that the host will fall off onto the paten or, God forbid, onto the floor. Therefore, open your mouth wide enough and extend your tongue far enough so that the priest can place the host easily on your tongue. Be aware of what you are doing. Note: Each country's Conference of Bishops determine the posture to be used for the reception of Communion and the act of reverence to be made by each person as he or she receives Communion.
