Dear brothers and sisters, sometimes we are so prejudiced that we fail to see the goodness in our people. What makes us fail to see the beauty of our people? Here is a beautiful story I shared in one of my weekly reflections. There was a woman who lived in a beautiful house. She possessed just about everything a person could dream of, but one thing always upset her. She said to her husband, "Just look at our neighbor's laundry. Doesn't it look more grey than white? On the other hand, ours is always so clean and white." She used to say that so often that her husband got used to it. And for years the two of them would discuss what possibly could be the cause of that grey laundry. One day while their house was being renovated, the lady and her husband went away for a short holiday to escape the turmoil of cleaning and painting, etc. When they returned, they immediately appreciated the glisten of the spotless home. Eventually the lady of the house looked out her window, and to her surprise, the neighbor's laundry was now white as snow. There was nothing grey about it. When she joyfully told her husband of this discovery, he smiled and told her, "The color of our neighbor's laundry has not changed; but what has, is the quality of the window through which you are looking at the world outside. It has a new glass in it now." The message is that we are challenged to clean our own window glass first in order to see the beauty of the world around us.
