

THE IMPORTANCE OF PRAYER DURING LENT

Prayer is one of the three pillars that serves to underscore the whole Lenten season, along with fasting and almsgiving. We know that prayer is always essentially important. It's the breath of the Christian spiritual life because it's the basis of our relationship with God. Prayer is something of great importance that we hear about often. The journey of Lent is one that summits on Good Friday, only to find final fulfillment in the celebration of Easter. It becomes wildly evident, considering this fact, that only a heart truly and authentically united to Christ will be ready and willing to accompany Him into this ultimate Lenten fulfillment – the agony of His torture and death on a cross. And this unity is necessary to make the full journey of Lent which calls us to Calvary, is found in prayer. It is by intentionally taking time to be alone with the Lord that we can let down our walls and open ourselves to really be transformed and perfected in Him, sharing in His life. This gives us the strength to follow Jesus to the end, and never leave His side. Union with Christ really is the point of Lent entirely. Because if we are united to Christ in His dying, then we can share in the new life offered through His resurrection. Lent is not about making yourself perfect. Lent is about uniting yourself to the One who is perfect and letting Him have at your heart. And so, our prayer does not have to be perfect. God just asks that we come to Him, give Him our time, and open ourselves to new life. You don't know how to pray? Put yourself in the presence of God, and as soon as you have said, 'Lord, I don't know how to pray!' you can be sure you've already begun. – St. Josemaria Escriva
