WHAT IS THE MEANING OF PENTECOST FOR THE JEWS AND CHRISTIANS?

Today we celebrate Pentecost Sunday. What is the meaning of Pentecost for the Jews and Christians? It was a harvest festival, signifying the end of the grain harvest. Deuteronomy 16 states: You shall count seven weeks; begin to count the seven weeks from the time you first put the sickle to the standing grain. Then you shall keep the feast of weeks to the Lord your God with the tribute of a freewill offering from your hand, which you shall give as the Lord your God blesses you; and you shall rejoice before the Lord your God [Dt. 16:9-11a]. In the Old Testament, it is referred to by several names: The feast of weeks, or the feast of harvest or the day of first-fruits. Today in Jewish circles it is known as Shavu`ot (Hebrew, "weeks"). As one of the most important solemnities on the Church's calendar, it has a rich depth of meaning for Christians. Here is how Pope Benedict summarized it in 2012: This Solemnity makes us remember and relive the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles and the other disciples gathered in prayer with the Virgin Mary in the Upper Room (cf. Acts 2:1-11). Jesus, risen and ascended into Heaven, sent his Spirit to the Church so that every Christian might participate in his own divine life and become his valid witness in the world. The Holy Spirit, breaking into history, defeats aridity, opens hearts to hope, stimulates and fosters in us an interior maturity in our relationship with God and with our neighbor. Happy Feast of Pentecost!
