TAKE: THIS IS MY BODY... THIS IS MY BLOOD

Today we celebrate Corpus Christi. We see in the book of Exodus, a detailed description of the covenant that Lord God made with Moses on behalf of the people of Israel. This covenant was sealed with the blood of animals. The covenant made between the Lord God and Moses was a pre-figuration of the new covenant that Jesus made and sealed with His own precious blood on Calvary. We have a detailed description of the events of the Last Supper of Jesus with His Apostles in the Gospels. Hence our life has to be transformed so as to become more like that of Jesus. 2.
