JUBILEE YEAR 2025 - PILGRIMS OF HOPE (Part-2)

Tradition Continues in Christianity: The first Christian jubilee was proclaimed by Pope Boniface VIII in 1300. It offered full remission of sins for those who confessed and made a pilgrimage to St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. Initially celebrated every 100 years, jubilee years were later reduced to intervals of 50 years, and eventually to 25 years. Pope Francis has proclaimed Jubilee 2025 in the Papal Bull Spes Non Confundit (Hope Does Not Disappoint), emphasizing hope as the hallmark of the year: "The coming Jubilee will thus be a Holy Year marked by the hope that does not fade—our hope in God. May it help us to recover the confident trust we require in the Church and society, in interpersonal relationships, and in promoting the dignity of all persons and respect for God's gift of creation." (Spes Non Confundit, 25). The Jubilee commenced in Rome on December 24, 2024, with the opening of the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica, and in local dioceses on Holy Family Sunday, December 29. It is set to conclude on December 28, 2025, in local dioceses and on January 6, 2026, in Rome, with the closing of the Holy Door.

Jubilee Indulgence: Special graces for the forgiveness of sins are offered during the Jubilee Year. The faithful may receive a plenary indulgence—remission of temporal punishment for sins—by meeting these conditions: Confession, reception of Holy Communion, prayer for the pope's intentions, and detachment from sin. Participating in activities such as pilgrimages, Eucharistic adoration, or performing works of mercy and penance. God Bless!
